The Big Ideas

Quiet Time

A "Quiet Time" is time invested in:

- Learning from God through His Word
- Acknowledging my dependence on the Lord and bringing my concerns before His throne
- Challenging and correcting my thinking
- Preparing to remind myself and encourage others about God's goodness

Why is it called a "Quiet Time"?

Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!

> Psalm 46:10 ESV

For God alone my soul waits in silence; from him comes my salvation.

> Psalm 62:1 FSV

The Gospel

 - Goal is meaningful times with God
