## Quiet Time

- Acknowledging my dependence on the Lord and bringing my concerns before His throne
- Challenging and correcting my thinking
- Preparing to remind myself and encourage others about God's goodness

  - Proverbs 15:8; Psalm 34:15; John 4:23
- Prayer is like an incense offering
  - Psalm 141:2; Revelation 5:8, 8:3, 4
- His Holy Spirit helps us
  - Galatians 4:6; Romans 8:26

# Our Relationship with God

- 1 O LORD, you have searched me and known me!
- 2 You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from afar.
- 3 You search out my path and my lying down and are acquainted with all my ways.
- 4 Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, O LORD, you know it altogether.
- 5 You hem me in, behind and before, and lay your hand upon me.
- 6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high; I cannot attain it.
